There will be ATA Youth Trap Shoots at 9am on both Saturday July 6th **and August 3**rd. These are AIM registered Youth Shoots. They will close the target range all morning until 1 or 2pm.

Bring the kids out to the Bluegill Round-up on Saturday, July 13th from 8am to noon. Our lakes are chock full of them, and they are fun to catch and great to eat. This is their opportunity to learn all about fishing for bluegill – how to cast, bait their hook and carefully take the fish off the hook. A cleaning station will be available to learn how to clean and prepare fish for eating. Prizes will be available for the kids and poles and bait will be available on a first come first serve basis. This event is open to the public. The fee is \$5.00 with kids under 5 free. Volunteers are needed so let our Lake Chairs, Alice Butterfield (708-466-3357) and Jackie Larson (219)-487-0001), know if you will be available.

Another big Lakes event coming up is our **Annual Catfish Derby on Saturday, July 27**th. It is open to the public so come on out and bring your friends. **Registration opens at 4pm, fishing starts at 5pm until 10pm**. Entry fee is \$25 for everyone and includes food. No boats allowed on the lakes, shore fishing only. NO glass bottles of any kind allowed on the grounds during this event (or at any time)! The lakes will be closed on Tuesday, July 23rd in preparation for the derby. They will re-open as usual once the event is over. Volunteers will be needed from 3pm to the end of the event. They will need the most help from 4 to 7pm to help with sign-ups and organization of the numerous contests.

The July Competition Shoot will be Saturday, July 20th. The first match will be a "Mozambique" timed drill. The shooter will fire 3 shots, on two targets, reload off the clock, and repeat the drill, for a total of 12 shots. Scores are calculated on time and accuracy. The second match will be rifles with optics, 10 shots sitting from the 50 yard bench. The August competition shoot will be Saturday, August 26^{th.} The first match will be pistols, 10 shots/offhand from the 7 yd line, and the second will be pistols, 10 shots/offhand, from the 25 yd line bench. For both shoots, the range opens for practice at 10am, and the first match is at 11. Range will re-open to members no later than 2pm.
