The 2025 Bass Tournament is Saturday, July 19th. It is open to the public and you are encouraged to help us spread the word. No fishing license needed. Registration is at 5:00am with fishing from 6:00am to noon. The entry fee is \$25 which includes breakfast. No boats allowed on the lakes, shore fishing only. NO glass bottles of any kind allowed on the grounds during this event (or at any time)! There will be tackle for sale as well as raffles and prizes. Bring your own bait. For more information, contact our Lakes Chairs Alice Butterfield (708-466-3357) or Jackie Larson (219)-487-0001). The lakes are closed to member fishing during the tournament.

Come on out to the club's kick-off event to celebrate our new playground on Saturday, July 26th from 11am to 4pm. This event is open to the public so bring your kids and all their friends to help us break in the new new playground train, swings, three climbers, slides and merry-go-round! We'll have free food including popcorn, cotton candy, pizza, hot dogs, chips, cookies and more! July 5th and August 2nd are ATA Youth Trap Shoots. These are AIM registered Youth Shoots. They will close the target range all morning until 1 or 2pm on both days. These shoots also close the back lakes to fishing.

The July Competition Shoot will be Saturday, July 12^{th.} The first match will be a "Mozambique" timed drill. The shooter will fire 3 shots, on two targets, reload off the clock, and repeat the drill, for a total of 12 shots. Scores are calculated on time and accuracy. The second match will be rifles with optics, 10 shots sitting from the 50 yard bench. The August competition shoot will be Saturday, August 16^{th.} The first match will be pistols, 10 shots/offhand from the 7 yd line, and the second will be pistols, 10 shots/offhand, from the 25 yd line. For both shoots, the range opens for practice at 10am, and the first match is at 11. Range will re-open to members no later than 2pm. The August 18th Lakes and Grounds meeting has been moved to August 11th to prepare for the Catfish Derby.

Our Annual Catfish Derby will be Saturday, August 16^{th.} It is open to the public so come on out and bring your friends.

Registration opens at 4pm, fishing starts at 5pm until 10pm. Entry fee is \$25 for everyone and includes food. No boats allowed on the lakes, shore fishing only.
